

Dorset Prosthetic Centre pre-amputation Consultation

This leaflet aims to tell you what a Pre-amputation Consultation is and to tell you what will happen. This leaflet is aimed at individuals who are considering amputation.

What is the appointment for?

The appointment is an opportunity to met with the Rehabilitation Consultant and discuss your medical reasons for considering an amputation. Hopefully you will gain insight into what it would be like to be a prosthetic user should you proceed with amputation and how we would be able to assist you with your rehabilitation.

In addition the following may be undertaken depending on your need:

- Discussion with the Consultant in Rehabilitation regarding pain control either before or after amputation.
- Meeting other members of the multi-disciplinary team,
- Viewing a prosthetic (artificial) leg
- Discussion regarding your thoughts and feelings about having an amputation and whether a referral to the counsellor would be helpful.
- Arranging a 'match' with an amputee in similar circumstances to yourself so that you can learn and be encouraged by their experience.
- Signposting to other services that may be helpful to you as you face different circumstances.
