Is there anything I need to avoid for the duration of my treatment?

It is important that you avoid the following:

- Sexual intercourse
- Smoking
- Alcohol
- Folic Acid Please see Ectopic Pregnancy Trust leaflet 'Medical Management' for more details about when you should restart taking the folic acid supplement
- Exposure to sun/ sunlamps
- Herbal remedies

Medications to avoid:

- Trimethroprim antibiotic
- Co-Trimoxazole antibiotic
- Ibuprofen non steroidal anti inflammatory
- Aspirin non steroidal anti inflammatory
- Diclofenac non steroidal anti inflammatory
- Mefenamic acid non steroidal anti inflammatory
