Before attending your appointment


Please answer the following questions:

Do you have a fever/high temperature?





Do you have a change or loss of taste and/or smell?


Do you have any **new** symptoms of shortness of breath?





Have you been in contact with anyone who has either a cough or fever in the 14 days prior to your appointment?

Have you been in contact with anyone confirmed to be Coronavirus positive?



If you answered yes to any of the questions, please do not enter the department but go home and call the number on your letter. We will happily rebook your appointment for you.

Please attend appointments alone where possible


If you arrive early, please wait in your car
