The journey has started – Poole!

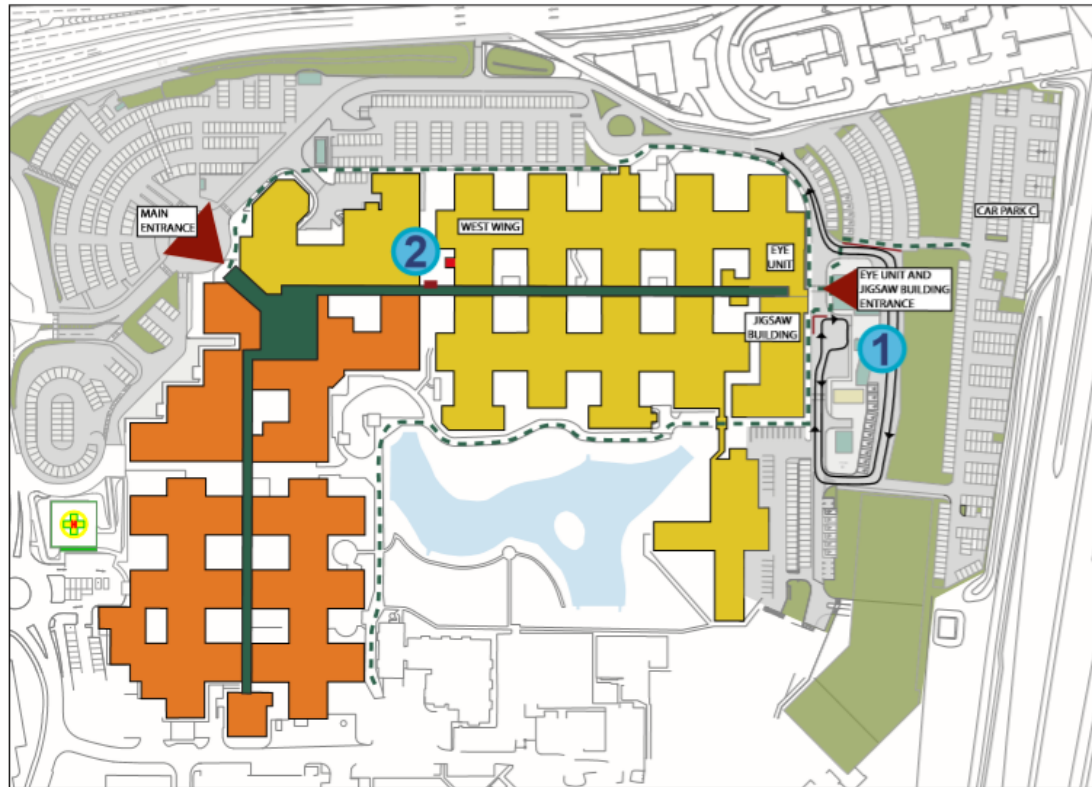
- Poole Theatres Enabling Work commenced October 2020
- £201m approved by the NHSE/I and ministers December 2020 (awaiting Treasury approval)
- Poole Theatres Phase A commenced on site January 2021



RBH Site Logistics – 3 phases through 2021

- **February 2021** – Changes to the West (Eye Unit) Entrance to create the main entrance for the next 3 years
- **March** Phase 1 of Construction for the Maternity, Childrens, Emergency & Critical Care Centre
- **October** Phase 2 of Construction for the Maternity, Childrens, Emergency & Critical Care Centre

Orthopaedic, Eye Unit & Jigsaw Building



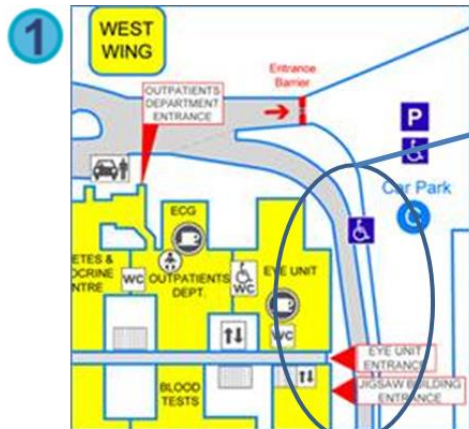
1 Improvements to the Eye Unit and Jigsaw Building Entrance

- To deliver a refurbished entrance, including a new reception and waiting area and a grab-and-go refreshment facility
- Start on site 1st February 2021
- Entry to the hospital street will be accessible throughout the duration of the project
- Project amends vehicle access route to include a new route past the west entrance
- Project due to complete August 2021

2 External access to Orthopaedics closes

- To deliver a brand new retail pharmacy and new patients' affairs accommodation
- Orthopaedic outpatients will only be accessible from the hospital street between February and June 2021
- Project due to complete August 2021

Changes to the Eye Unit & Jigsaw Building entrance road layout

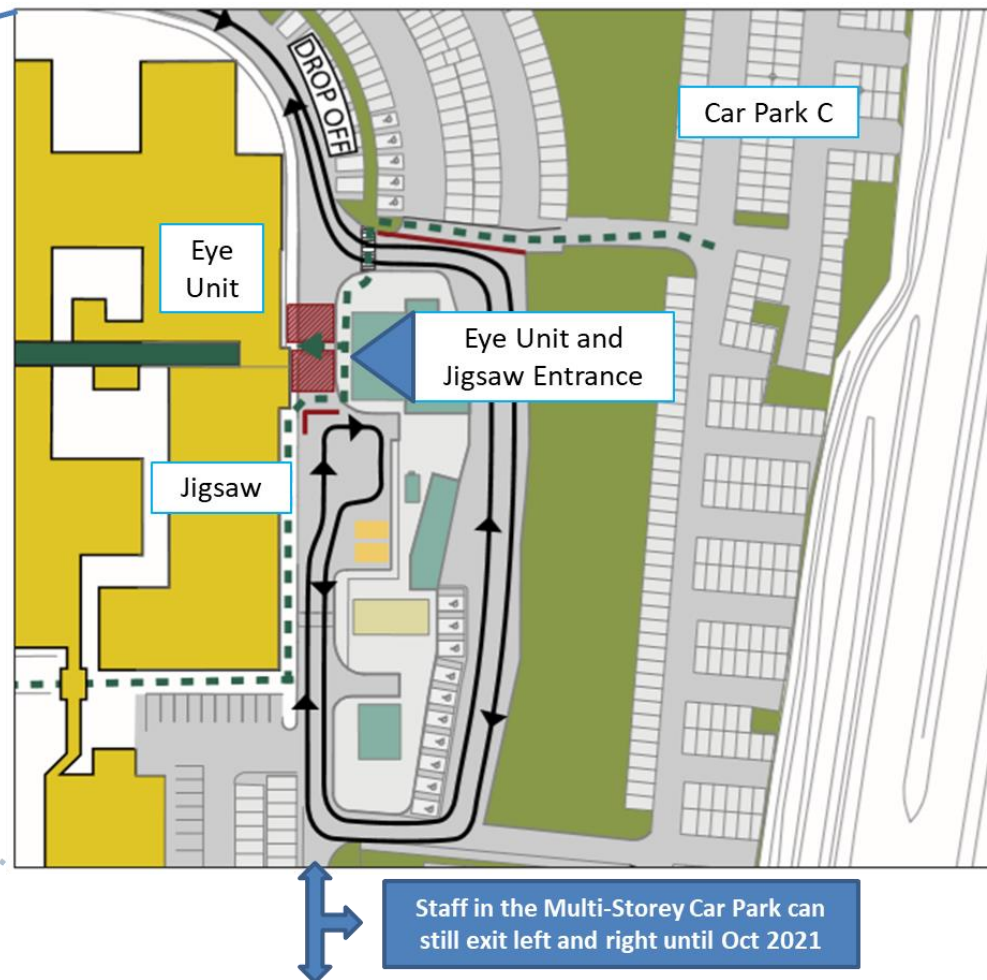


Pedestrian access

- A pedestrian route from the car parks to the Eye Unit and Jigsaw Building Entrance is to be provided

Vehicular route & Patient Drop Off

- Vehicles will not be able to drive past the Eye Unit and Jigsaw Building Entrance.
- A two-way road with a turning point will be provided
- A drop off area linking to the pedestrian crossing will provide a safe area for patient set downs.
- Disabled parking will be moved to facilitate pedestrian access.
- Ambulance drop off is adjacent to Eye Unit and Jigsaw Building Entrance.

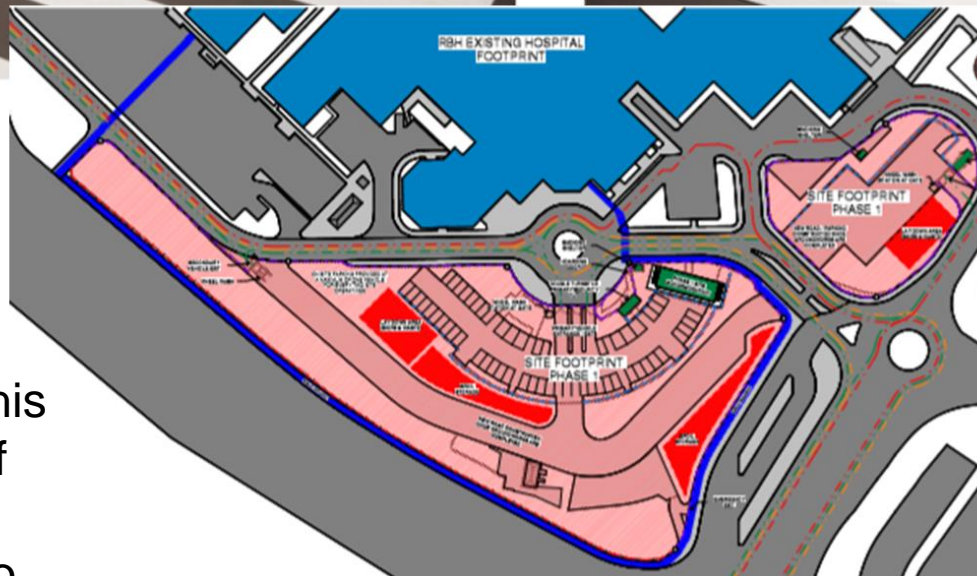

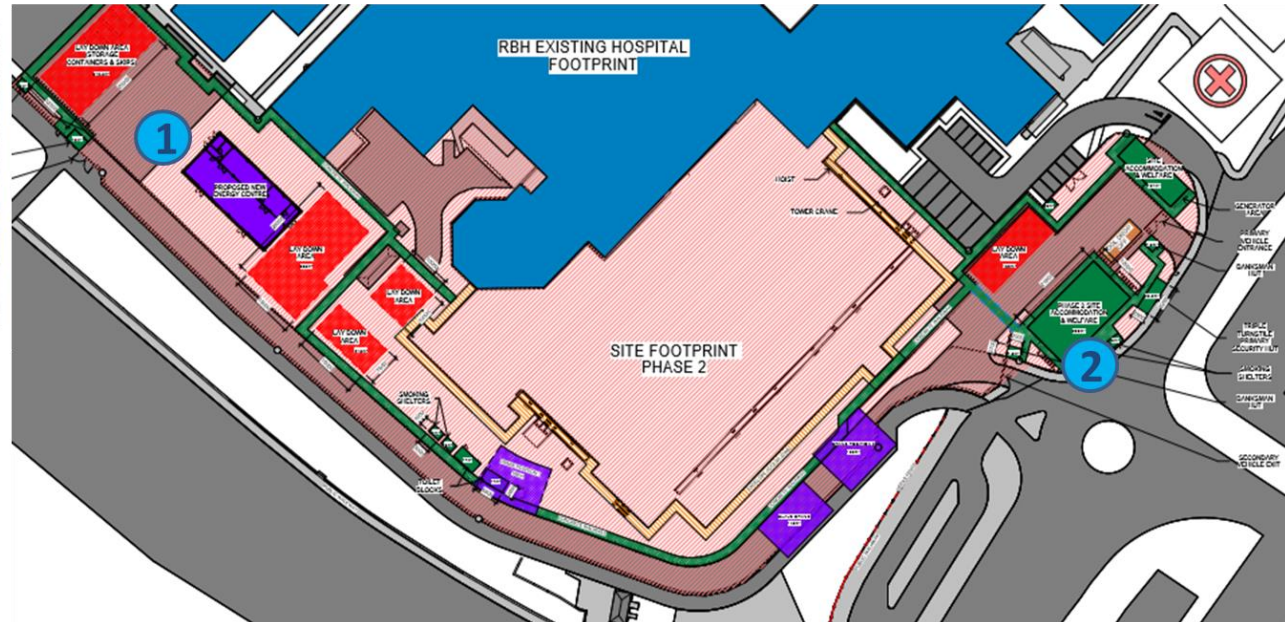

PRIMARY VEHICLE ENTRANCE & SITE ACCOMMODATION 3D VISUAL



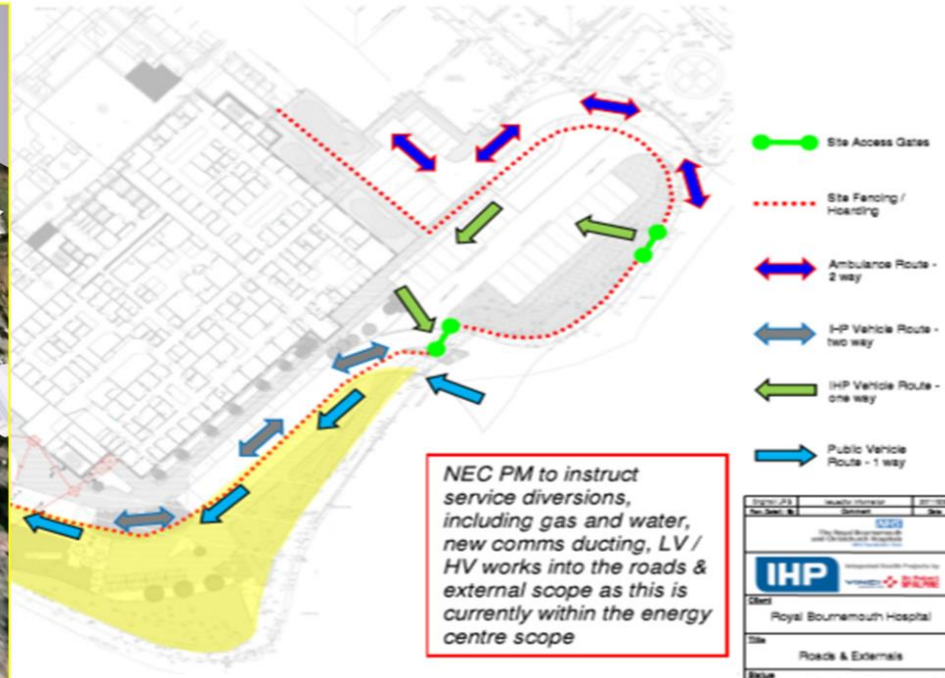

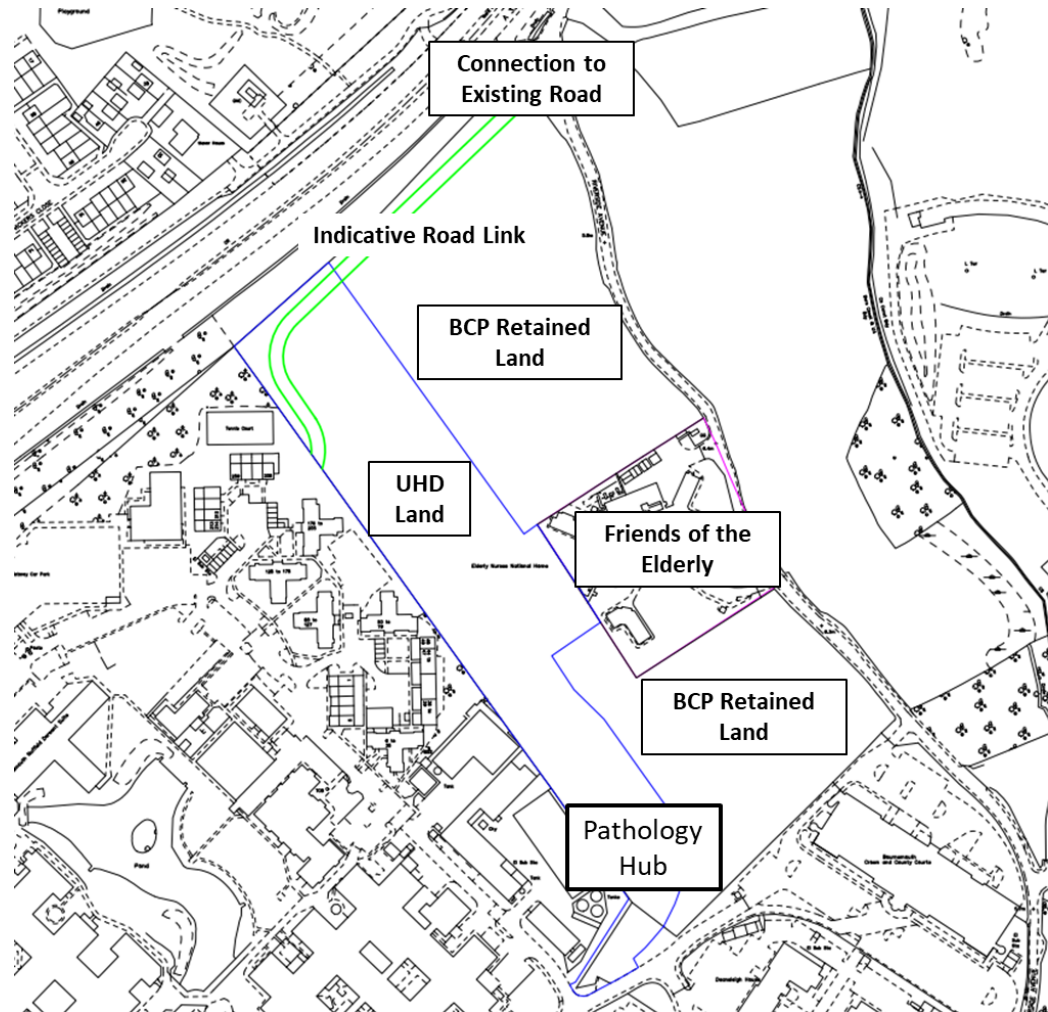
Transport & Car Parking

- Additional spaces at Littledown to offset loss of staff parking
- Patients and visitors use more parking at West/Eye Unit end of site with Buggy Pick Up support
- Continue to reduce traffic e.g. community based services (blood tests, physio, DOSH) and virtual clinics, plus staff working from home



New road access

- Purchasing of land from BCP underway
- BCP to construct a road linking A338 Wessex Way to RBH, near to the Multi-Storey Car Park
- Left in/left out junction
- Timeline to be agreed
