
Uber Medics - 25% discounted Rides for University Hospitals Dorset


ACTION NEEDED for access:

- 4. You are now linked to Medics discount rider account
 Please note that it may take up to 24 hours for Uber Medics to appear on your Uber App
- 5. **To get 25% of all trips** Select the 25% Medics Discount profile then choose the Uber Medics vehicle and request a ride.

Tips for safe riding

We are especially thankful to drivers whose efforts are essential to keeping our NHS and care staff moving during this challenging time. We ask that you please keep your driver's wellbeing in mind by:

- Wearing face coverings or masks at all times, as legally required
- Washing your hands (or using hand sanitiser) before entering the vehicle
- Giving your driver space by sitting in the back seat on the left hand side of the vehicle
- Covering your mouth or nose if you cough or sneeze (take any used tissues with you)
- Opening the window to improve ventilation.

Drivers have been given the same reminders to ensure trips with Uber are as safe as possible. Uber is also providing drivers with free hygiene kits, which include face coverings, hand sanitisers, and cleaning material. Drivers are asked to disinfect their cars between trips, paying special attention to frequently touched areas like car door handles and seat belts.
