
ESR / Payroll Scams

We have been made aware of a new ESR Scam being sent out to staff. This suggests there is an issue with your salary and instructs you to follow a link to rectify the 'issue'. The link will take you to a fake ESR log in page that is made to look genuine but is owned by the fraudster.

Any details, personal or financial, that you input to this website is then in the hands of the fraudster.

Fraudsters seek to instill a sense of urgency or panic to be successful in drawing their victims in. It is always best to take stock of the information and then review the intranet for contact details to the department that can assist you.

Do not click on any links in the email and verify any numbers on the email before calling them.
