Update from the outpatients workstream – POOLE STAFF

- All computers now allow you to access both Poole and RBH (UHD) versions of eCaMIS. Please select 'PHT Live' for Poole clinics up to and including 16 May. Please select 'RBH Live' for all clinics from 17 May onwards.
- You can access both Poole and RBH/UHD clinics at the same time. To do this ensure you log into 'PHT Live' first then open a new window to log into 'RBH Live'.
- Please DO NOT send letters to the virtual printer as this is currently not ready. Any letters that need to be printed should be done locally.

Theatres and elective admissions progress

- All staff have been given log-ins for the UHD PAS. Please check with your line manager if you have not received yours yet.
- Admissions for procedures beyond 17 May can no longer be booked on the Poole eCaMIS.
- We're working to enable the booking of procedures from 17 May onwards on the UHD PAS including **obstetrics, endoscopy, planned surgical admissions and emergency theatres**. We will update you when this facility is available

Inpatients workstream updates

- 'On the day' cutover processes for 17 May are being finalised and will be shared with care group and operational teams.
- Any PAS downtime for wards will be minimised as far as possible – primarily affecting Poole users while patients are moved across to the new system.
- Links with other key systems such as Health of the Ward and EPMA will also be restored as quickly as possible.

About the single PAS project

The project to provide University Hospitals Dorset with a single PAS provides a range of important benefits. It is a combination of the two separate PAS systems historically used by Poole Hospitals and the Royal Bournemouth and Christchurch hospitals. Unlike some IT projects with a 'big bang' launch date, UHD PAS is a rolling implementation, with clinics and specialties being added all the time. By 17 May this year, all PAS activity will be on the new shared UHD PAS.

Benefits at a glance:

- allows the creation of single waiting lists at specialty level across all sites
- standardises waiting times across UHD
- offers improved patient choice about where they are seen
- more efficient booking processes, utilising just one PAS episode
- is an evolution of the PAS systems used currently
- makes more efficient use of our resources.
