3.2 Vascular Emergencies in THEATRES at SPOKE HOSPITALS

Bleeding, intraoperative vascular trauma, intraoperative acute ischaemia, including supracondylar fracture

- Attempt control of any haemorrhage with pressure.
- <u>IN-HOURS:</u> Contact Vascular Surgeon ON-SITE if available, via local switchboard, if no provision exists on-site, call the **on-call Vascular Consultant via Bournemouth**.
- <u>OUT of HOURS</u>: Contact Vascular CONSULTANT on-call via Royal Bournemouth
 Hospital switchboard 01202 303626. Ask SPECIFICALLY for VASCULAR CONSULTANT.

 <u>If SpR is operating at Spoke, Consultant Responsible for the Patient should be</u>
 called to attend IMMEDIATELY.



VASCULAR CONSULTANT ON-CALL will:

- Give advice.
- Contact on-site surgeon if possible. Consider **contacting a more local surgeon if available** OOH, or if on-call is busy operating at Hub.
- If required to travel: 1) attempt to FIND CONSULTANT COVER, 2) inform RBH DUTY
 MANAGER and inform SpR on-call of absence (and cover if identified), 3) pick up
 emergency travel pack from theatres at RBH if necessary.

SpR on-call at Hub will:

- Take all referrals and discuss with Vascular Consultant where necessary.
- Call in covering Vascular Consultant from home in event of dire emergency.

INCIDENT FORMS should be submitted AT HUB AND SPOKE SITES.
