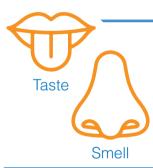
Please answer the following questions:

Have you been identified as a contact of confirmed Covid-19 case via the formal track and trace route in the past 14 days?

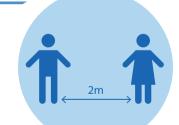


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If you have answered '**NO**' to all of the questions, you may attend your appointment.
