

# Advice for visitors

Thank you for visiting today - it makes a huge difference to our patients.

While we welcome visiting, we do need to ensure it is in a very careful and Covid-secure way. Therefore we ask you to:

- take a lateral flow test before visiting the hospital - you can order free tests from [www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk)
- always wash or gel your hands when entering and leaving the hospital and ward
- wear a face covering and any other PPE required for the ward you are visiting - you'll see our staff are all wearing them too
- **not** visit our hospital if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, are self-isolating or have diarrhoea, vomiting or any other infectious condition
- Covid has not gone away - please consider wearing a face covering in busy places outside of our hospitals as we believe this has made a huge difference in infection rates.

## When you leave the ward

- Make sure you dispose of any personal protective equipment in the bins provided and wash your hands.
- Use your own face covering as you exit the hospital and keep it on until you have left the building.
